

Pre-Treatment Instructions for Pellevé

- 1. Remove makeup and wash facial area prior to treatment.
- 2. Botox or filler should be given post treatment or a minimum of 2 weeks prior to a Pellevé procedure.
- 3. For two weeks prior to Pellevé avoid treatments which may cause erythema (redness) or irritation (Obagi System treatments, Retin-A or products containing Isotetrinoin, glycolic or salicylic acid).
- 4. The treatment area must be free of any open lesions or infections.
- 5. Avoid anti inflammatory medications the day of treatment. OTC: Advil, Motrin, (Ibuprofen), Aleve. By prescription: Celebrex, DayPro, Relafen. These medications may inhibit the desired inflammatory response.



Post-Treatment Instructions for Pellevé

Typically, you may return to your normal activities after Pellevé. You should follow the medical advice of your physician regarding the care of your skin.

- 1. Wash skin with tepid water and a gentle cleanser.
- 2. If the skin is slightly pink or red in areas following the treatment, avoid hot water when washing or showering until any pink has subsided.
- 3. Makeup (preferably mineral-based) may be applied immediately post treatment.
- 4. Soothing, non-irritating creams or moisturizers may be used.
- 5. Use a sun block with an SPF of 30 or greater if going out into the sun to help prevent future sun damage. This treatment does not cause photosensitivity.
- 6. Avoid anti-inflammatory drugs for 24 hours. OTC: Advil, Motrin, (Ibuprofen), Aleve. By prescription: Celebrex, DayPro, Relafen.
